



MAGNIVA PLATINUM 3 is a premixture of silage additives for the preservation and aerobic stability of gramineas, legumes and perennial grasses forages with more than 30% DM, intended for all animal species.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

MAGNIVA PLATINUM 3 is applied at a rate of 2 g/t of fresh forage. A 100 g sachet treats 50 t of fresh forage, and a 200 g sachet treats 100 t of fresh forage.

Mix sachet contents thoroughly by stirring into a minimum of 500 ml (100 g sachet), and 1 l (200 g sachet) clean potable water at ambient temperature. Transfer to applicator tank and make up to final volume as required, again using clean potable water at ambient temperature. Ensure all applicators are calibrated and thoroughly cleaned to remove any residues from previously used products.

When using standard spray applicators, apply product at minimum of 250 ml/t of fresh forage.

For balers and forage wagons, apply at minimum of 1 l/t of fresh

The product may also be applied using a specific low volume applicator, at a minimum of 10 ml/t of fresh forage (not suitable for balers or forage wagons).

Dilution should be adapted to appropriate applicator types.
